



PREFACE.

THE present work consists wholly of passages of Scripture, embracing a variety of interesting and instructive subjects relating to the past, the present, and the future. The use of illustrations of natural objects in imparting knowledge to others accords with a principle which has numerous examples in both the Old Testament and the New. God. when speaking through His servants, was often pleased to employ material things (either animate, as animals, birds, insects-or inanimate, as rocks, trees, streams) to illustrate and enforce spiritual truths.
