NOTE.

THE want of a General Index to the thirty-two Volumes of The Collected Writings of the late J. N. D. already published being greatly felt, it has been deemed advisable —pending the preparation of a full Subject-Index to the complete Collection—to issue the present little work for immediate use.

It gives the Titles, Headings, and Sub-Headings of the Essays and Papers contained in the first thirty-two Volumes, alphabetically arranged, and the length of each is shewn by both its first and last pages being given.

An Index-Number is attached to each Article, and to independent chapters and divisions, for facility of reference and quotation, and Cross-References are furnished in abundance.

It appears to be impossible to determine the exact dates of the several Writings, but the dates of publication of a considerable number of those that first appeared in "The Christian Witness," "The Present Testimony," "The Bible Treasury," and other well-known serials are given as affording an approximation.

The Scriptures or Texts forming the subject of each paper are generally to be found in its Heading; but a separate List of these, arranged in the order of the Books of the Bible, is added, each Text bearing the Index Number of the paper or chapter in which it has been

dealt with.
