"Behold, He cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see Him, and they also which pierced Him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of Him. Even so-Amen."

Behold! He cometh. He who "was despised and rejected of men." He who is now crowned with glory at God's right hand!

He comes "in His glory, with all the holy angels" and ten thousands of His saints." He comes to take "vengeance on them that know not God and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ." Then "shall all the tribes of the earth see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven."

"All kindreds of the earth shall wail because of Him." Then shall the wicked "be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of His power, when He shall come to be glorified in His saints, and to be admired in all them that believe."

Alas, poor world! well may you run "into the clefts of the rocks, and into the tops of the ragged rocks, for fear of the Lord, and for the glory of His majesty, when He ariseth to shake terribly the earth." Then "every eve shall see Him,"-young, old, high,

low, rich, poor, - the king, the slave, the servant and the master-"every eye shall see Him, and they also which pierced Him." "As it was in the days of Noah, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man. They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all. Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot-they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded; but the same day that Lot went out of Sodom, it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed them all. Even thus shall it be in the day when the son of man is revealed."

"And all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of Him." One cry shall be heard from men of every tribe and colour under heaven-from Jew, Greek, bond and free. The coming of Him whom they had rejected will fill

all with unutterable anguish and despair; all their scenes of mirth and madness will for ever have ended. giving place, in a moment, to one wild expression of dismay, when the blaze of the glory of Jesus the Son of God, shall burst through the opening heavens. "Howl ve; for the day of the Lord is at hand; it shall come as a destruction from the Almightv.
